### Slido Voting System – Guidance for Presenters

Please send in your whole PowerPoint presentation, with the question slides positioned where you want them to appear within the presentation. Please clearly mark these slides as QUESTION slides.

Your questions will be formulated into slides compatible with the Slido system. If you require your own slide template, please send this with your questions. The information that you need to send is simple, formulate your questions as follows:

**QUESTION** – *this needs to be worded for a multiple-choice response*

The weather on 2 June was...?

**ANSWER** – *formulate your answers by adding a series of answer choices, e.g.:*

1. Sunny
2. Cloudy
3. Cold
4. Rainy
5. Windy

You may have up to 10 answer choices, although we recommend less!

#### **DURING YOUR PRESENTATION**

- Ask the question on the slide with the answer options
- Tell the audience when to start voting, then wait 10 seconds (there will be a countdown on the screen)
- Delegates have 10 seconds to vote and within those 10 seconds individuals can change their answer by simply selecting a different button
- The countdown will confirm when the 10 seconds have finished
- Press the next slide button (and wait a few seconds) to display the results
- Results will be displayed once voting has been polled through at the end of the 10 seconds
- The results will be shown via a bar chart

**NOTE:** Once the question slide is on screen, voting is immediately open. Therefore, if you leave this slide before finishing the voting and waiting for the results to be revealed, then there's a chance it could hinder the outcome. AV technicians will be in the room should there be any problems with the voting during the session, so please just ask for their assistance.
