EARLY BOOKING IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED.

The Early Bird booking deadline is 14:00 on **WEDNESDAY 27 MAY 2026**

For catering and organisation purposes we ask that all participants register in advance and preferably before 09:00 on Tuesday 7 July. However, registration will be open until 12:00 on Friday 10 July. You may also register on the day of the Meeting, either onsite or online, but if the venue is full, BTS reserves the right to refuse admission to those who try to book on the day.

THIS IS AN ONSITE ONLY EVENT

The delegate fee for the Meeting includes a two-course lunch and tea/coffee/water during the early morning, mid-morning and afternoon refreshment breaks. Please confirm your dietary and access requirements when making your booking.

RECORDINGS

After the event, all delegates who have attended the Meeting will be sent a website link (via the BTS Events app) giving access for three months to video recordings of the main sessions and guest lecture. Access to recordings is provided as per the days you have registered (e.g. if you registered to attend Thursday, you will receive content from the Thursday, but not Friday, and visa versa).

AWARD CEREMONY AND PRESIDENT'S RECEPTION

The President's Reception will be held on Thursday 9 July from 6.00pm to 7.00pm. This is free of charge but, for catering purposes, we need to know whether you want to attend. The BTS President will present the awards for the Clinical Grand Round competition and the Abstract Prizes at the reception.

When paying by invoice, a Purchase Order Form must be received two weeks prior to the event and **BTS can only invoice a Finance department**.
